Hello Dolly! Caseville Historical Society Museum goes Country this weekend

The Historical Society of Caseville Museum will become a highlight of the community's Denim & Diamond/Dolly Pardon celebration this weekend. The museum will transform into a Dolly Pardon mecca on Thursday in time for the Friday kick-off of the event.

Brandon Dean, of Cottage Outfitters in Caseville and a collector of Parton memorabilia, will bring part of his Dolly collection to the museum and deck it out in honor of the Country crooner. The take-down of the museum-wide exhibit will occur Sunday. Plans were finalized during the historical society's regularly scheduled meeting on July 16.

Members also heard plans for the upcoming Cheeseburger in Caseville Festival in August. Trustee Cathy Snider, event coordinator, updated members on the 10-day event. 500 Key-lime pie bars have been ordered from Key West. Trustee Harold Hoelzle is gathering items for his popular "What is It?" contest. Members Nola Doak and Dave Vizard will begin collecting gift baskets and gift certificates from local merchants for the Cheeseburger Festival and the Caseville Classic Car Show in September.

Members also received a report from Trustee Rich Bass on the need for fire extinguishers for the museum. A motion was made by Trustee Sherry Hoelzle, seconded by Trustee Dale Melson, and passed by members to purchase three extinguishers from Hunter's Fire Protection of Elkton for \$106 each.

Since our last meeting, 10 members attended CPR and AED training, conducted by Scheurer Hospital, at the museum. Each member became certified with the formal training.

- Except for events, we had 95 visitors to the museum in the last month.
